Course Description:

Congratulations on choosing Concert Band and welcome! In this course, you will be presented with many opportunities to discover and enhance your skills as a performance, listener and composer.

Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, we are currently facing restrictions regarding ensemble playing at school. AS such, modifications to the Concert Band program will be made in order for students to safely engage in the course materials. As policies continue to change, so will the delivery of the course materials. At this time, students will have the opportunity to pick from four options – virtual concert band, strings, guitar and percussion ensemble - in order to engage in the course content this year. They will be placed in cohorts based on their selection.

Course Objectives and Assessment:

Concert Band is a performance-based program and, as such, the learning environment must be conducive to creativity and risk-taking. Students are expected to contribute a positive attitude and a consistent work ethic. The key components of this group-based activity are regular, punctual attendance along with an emotionally/socially supportive and trusting environment. Students are expected to contribute to that environment through positive participation, positive attitude and mutual respect and support of one another, their teachers and the facility.

Over the course of the 2020-2021 school year, Nelson Mandela High School teachers will maintain an online course presence containing materials, resources, assignments and supports through our D2L environment. It is important for students to take an active role in their learning and stay current in their schoolwork if away for any reason.
